

AFTER THE FOOD AND FUND DRIVE

SAH AWARDS:



First place plaques will be given to elementary, intermediate and high schools. Awards are based on the total weight of collected donations (including Pound\$ for Dollar\$) divided by the number of students in the school.

The school that raises the most pounds of food per student overall will receive the Students Against Hunger Traveling Trophy. Last year, Bishop McGuinness Catholic High School raised 66,270 pounds of food for hungry Oklahomans.

POUND\$ FOR DOLLAR\$:

Every dollar your school raises will be converted into 6 pounds of food. Parents, friends, and family can support your food and fund drive by making a monetary gift!

All cash and check monetary gifts need to be turned into Natalie Price at the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma in order to receive credit. Gifts can also be made online at www.feedok.org and remember to write the name of your school on the donation form so your school will be properly credited. Make all checks out to the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma. Write "SAH" and your school name on the memo line. If you would like gift envelopes to pass out to students, just let us know and we will provide them.

SAH PICK UP:

The Regional Food Bank will send you an email with the name and contact information of the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma's partner agency that will be picking up your canned food donations the week of November 14, 2016. The partner agency will contact you to arrange this pick up.

Please remember to mail all monetary gifts to Natalie Price in the provided gift envelope, or contact the Regional Food Bank to have a staff member pick up the gifts from your school. Please send checks only -- **DO NOT MAIL CASH.**
